George Gershwin (1898 - 1937) American

About: Was an American composer and pianist. Gershwin's compositions spanned both popular and classical genres, and his most popular melodies are widely known. He composed mostly movie music.

Sergei Prokofiev (1891 - 1953) Russian

About: Noted as composer of stage music, Symphonies and concertos. Internationally famous programme music titled, 'Peter and the Wolf' is a fine work done by the composer. This music composition introduces orchestral instruments imitating different characters. They are,

The hunters – Timpani and the Bass Drum


Grand father - Bassoon


Western Music

Bela Bartok (1881 - 1945) Hungarian

About: A composer and pianist. He is considered as one of the most important composers of the 20th century. He and Liszt are regarded as Hungary's greatest composers. Bartok touched mostly on Folk music of Hungary. His music was influenced by

central European folk idioms.
