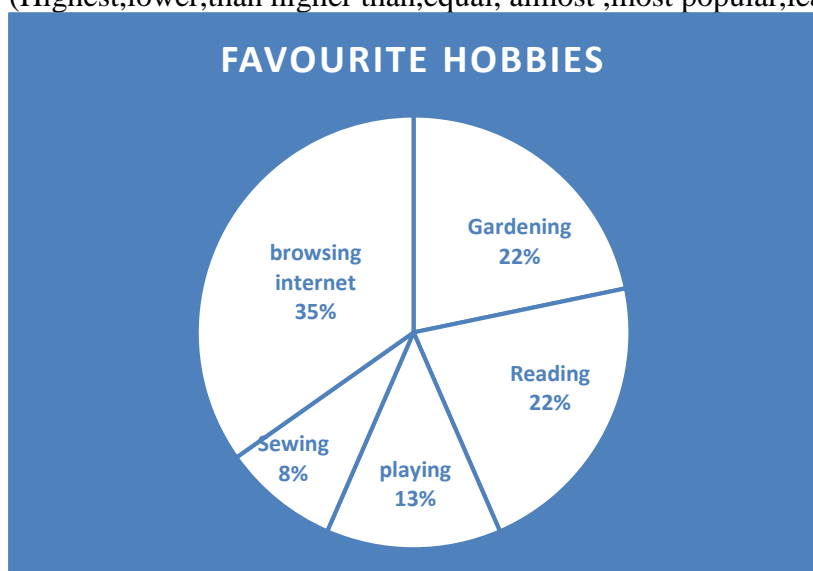

Unlike traditional software, AI can learn from experience. By processing large amount of data, it improves its performance over time.

AI is already a part of our daily lives. Virtual assistants like Siri or Alexa answer questions and set reminders. Online platforms use AI to recommend movies, music, or products based on our preferences. In healthcare, AI helps doctors detect diseases early by analyzing scans and medical records.
